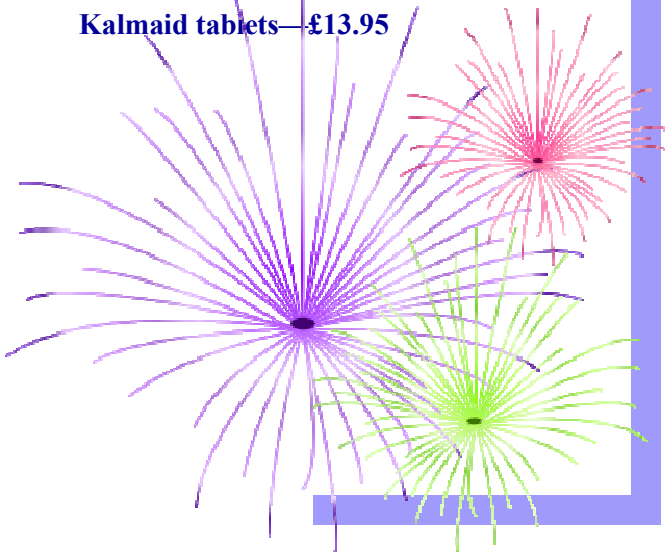

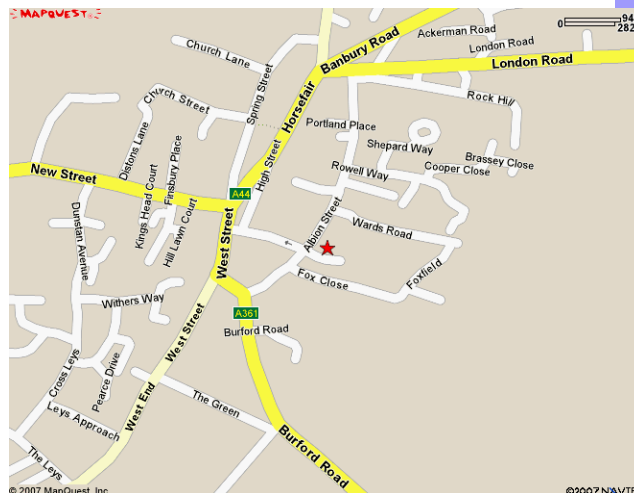

Signs of Stress

CATS

During the firework season many cats become stressed and fearful, displaying a range of symptoms which may include:

- Covering and hiding behind or on top of furniture
- Trying to run away
- Soiling the house
- Refusing to eat

DOGS

If you are wondering whether your dog is having trouble coping with loud noises, check this list of symptoms:

- Trembling and shaking
- Clinging to owners
- Barking excessively
- Trembling and shaking
- Covering and hiding behind furniture
- Trying to run away
- Soiling the house
- Pacing and panting
- Refusing to eat

3 Top Tips for Fireworks

- Provide a den or cover area where your pet can feel safe.
- Increase the feeling of security by plugging in an adaptil or felihway as close to the den or hiding place as possible.
- Administer KalmAid 90 minutes before fireworks start, or before dark if unsure of times.

Adaptil and Feliway

Adaptil come in 3 different forms

Adaptil Diffuser - Plug the diffuser into the room where your dog spends most of its time. Lasts up to 4 weeks.

Adaptil spray - Spray onto your dogs bedding, in it crate or the car. Convenient formulation for intermittent use.

Adaptil Collar - Available in 2 sizes : small and large. Fitted snugly around your dogs neck, this collar will ensure the appeasing pheromone is with your dog wherever he goes. Lasts for 4 weeks.



Feliway comes in 2 different forms.

Feliway Diffuser - Plug the diffuser into the room where your cat spends most of its time. Lasts up to 4 weeks.

Feliway Spray - Apply daily to areas that your cat scratches or sprays, or to new items of furniture in your house.
